Rev. Brittany Monchele' McCoy, lovingly known as "Pastor B," was born on December 29, 1986, to Mary A. Douglass-Pridgen and Craig T. Smith in Baltimore, Maryland. She received her early education at St. Katherine's School and then attended the Institute of Notre Dame, where she received her high school diploma in 2004.
